Public Participation Sessions in Council Meetings

Councils are reminded that it is good practice at council meetings to hold a public participation session to afford members of the public an opportunity to ask questions, give an opinion or raise concerns. While this is often confined to items on the agenda, some councils allow more flexibility to enable broader parish issues to be identified.

The practice of closing a meeting prior to the start of a public participation session (and resuming again afterwards) is outdated and contrary to legal advice. Such a session forms part of the meeting in law, should be included on the agenda, managed by the Chairman and documented in the minutes. The minutes should however be succinct and might only record a list of the topics raised. They should not, in particular, record the names or other personal data of individual members of the public taking part.
